ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 74 (UTILITIES) OF THE CITY OF LYONS BY ADJUSTING FIRE PROTECTION AND DELINQUENT ACCOUNT FEE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lyons, Georgia, at it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, as follows

That Chapter 74 (Utilities) Article II, Division 2 (Service Rates and Charges), Sec 74-58 is hereby amended by adding additional classifications and rates

**Which shall read as follows:**

A fee scheduled shall be imposed on all residential and commercial properties serviced with water by the City for the purpose of fire protection. The Fee assessed shall be imposed and reflect on each water statement. The fee schedule is as follows:

Rate Type	Fee per month
Residential (Single Family and Multi Family)	\$2.00 per living unit
Commercial - 5,000 sq. foot	\$4.00
Commercial - 5,000 sq. foot or greater	\$10.00
Church	\$10.00
Restaurant or Fuel Station	\$15.00
Self Storage Facility	\$15.00
Hotel / Motel	\$4.00 per unit

That Chapter 74 (Utilities), Article II, Division 2 (Service Rates and Charges), Sec 74-61 (2) and (3) is hereby amended by adjusting reconnection rates

**Which shall read as follows:**

(2) A disconnect for service will be initiated on the regular business day following the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month if a water bill has an outstanding balance.

(3) Water and sewer service shall not be reconnected until the customer's delinquent bill, including penalty and delinquent account fee charges, have been paid in full. Should such customer thereafter desire to be reconnected to the water and sewer system, a delinquent account

fee charge of \$100.00 and any outstanding fees shall be collected. Bills shall be paid at the city hall, and a failure to receive bills or notices shall not prevent such bills from becoming delinquent nor relieve the customer from payment of the bill.
